Conclusion

- Surgery for **acute** pulmonary embolism is last treatment option
 - Contraindication/failed thrombolysis
 - Shock
- PEA in **chronic**TEPH is standard and recommended treatment
- ECMO should be a standard of care in PEA centers
- Role of percutaneous pulmonary angioplasty needs further evaluation and so far can't replace PEA
- CTEPH team assess operability before other treatments are considered
